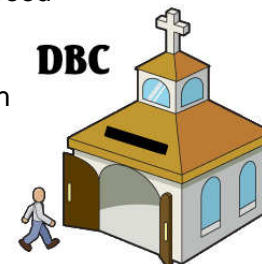
Saturday 24th February, 10am-4pm
